Distance markers are located on the ocean beach at 2km intervals north (N followed by an even number) and south (S and an odd number) of Middle Road. In an emergency dial 000 or if no mobile reception try 112. If calling from ocean beach, advise operator of your closest distance marker.



Caution: At times, exposed rocks make beaches impassable, especially after rough sea conditions.



PLEASE NOTE:

- Tangalooma is a vehicle free resort. You will need to park in one of the Resort car parks upon arrival and then walk to reception to check in.
- The North car park is approximately 600 metres from reception.
- Luggage trolleys are generally available at the car parks for guest use. Concrete paths run from both car parks to the main resort area.
- Please go to reception for check in.
- Please check the tides before travelling – all beaches to the resort are not usually passable within 2 hours of high tide.
- Check your tyre manufacturers guidelines for operation in soft sand. Most vehicles require a tyre pressure of 12-15 psi to operate effectively on sand. Ensure that your vehicle is engaged in 4WD mode.
- There are no facilities at Tangalooma Resort to purchase fuel or to complete mechanical repairs.
- Moreton Island is 4WD access only.
- Mobile phone reception is poor in some areas.

WARNING: Beach from Tangalooma to Kooringal is considered dangerous and we recommend no vehicle access.

Please take care when driving. Be aware of wildlife and birdlife. Do not leave rubbish behind.
