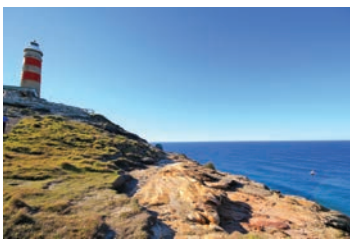


Desert Safari Tour with Sand Tobogganing

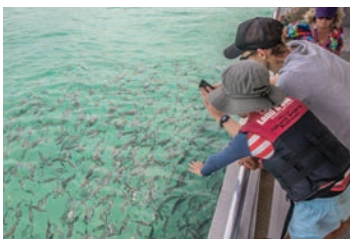

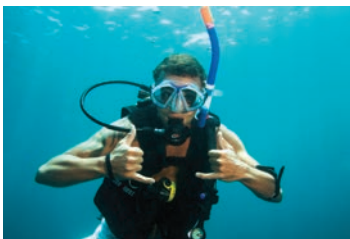
Fishing Tour (Catch and Release)
